### Al-Andalus Pass: a view of the Andalusia's most impressive monuments

An **Introduction to classical Seville**, a 2h 30min guided walking tour discovering the old quarter "Barrio de Santa Cruz" and other surroundings and exteriors of main monuments.

The **Mosque of Córdoba**, is the most important Islamic monument in Western Europe and one of the biggest mosques in the world. It is considered to be one of the most spectacular buildings ever constructed and dates back to the IX century. It is also classified as World Heritage by UNESCO.

The **Alhambra of Granada**, with its spectacular Generalife Gardens was the residential palace of the Nasrids Sultans and is now classified as World Heritage by UNESCO. The Alhambra was the last bastion of a splendid civilization leaving marvelous palaces, gardens, mosques, baths and fountains.\*
