## Jordan - Footsteps of Lawrence of Arabia

### The Riding

The horses are all Arabians. They are active, forward-going and fun to ride so you need to be a confident rider, able to control a horse at all paces in wide open spaces. There are some long trots and canters so riders also need to be fit.

This is three holidays rolled into one - visiting some of the great sights of Jordan, riding in the Wadi Rum and relaxing at the Dead Sea.

You begin in Madaba, near to Amman and continue south to Petra to explore the fascinating ruins of the "rose red city". The next morning drive to Wadi Rum to meet your horses. The pink sands of this unique landscape stretch as far as the eye can see, broken only by bizarre rock formations rising up vertically from the desert floor and sculpted by the wind over millions of years.

After the ride continue onto the Dead Sea for its therapeutic salt and mud treatments.

For the three nights in hotels, you can choose to stay in three, four or five star hotels. You camp in the desert for six nights in a simple tented camp.

Extensions can be arranged for you to stay longer at Madaba or the Dead Sea, or to visit other parts of Jordan such as the Red Sea.
