The Riding

The horses are mainly Andalucian and Spanish-Arab crosses ridden in English tack. You should be confident at all paces riding a forward going and responsive horse. The pace is varied and there are opportunities for exhilarating canters and gallops in the forest and, depending on the season, along the beach. Weight limit for the Andalucian horses is 83kg, but there are one or two horses suitable for riders up to 100kg.

In this quiet part of rural Spain you will find a warm welcome, well trained horses and fabulous riding. A network of soft sandy tracks are just waiting to be cantered along and the long golden beaches stretch on for miles. Ride through beautifully fragrant umbrella pine and eucalyptus forests and along ancient drovers' tracks which wind their way through the beautiful La Breña National Park.

After an exhilarating day in the saddle, return to the lovely hacienda 'Jacaranda' with its swimming pool and spacious gardens.

Between mid June and mid September, it is not possible to ride on the beach close to the water's edge.
